



**KENT COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**HIGHRIDGE, HYTHE**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2017**

To allow water mains replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Highridge, Hythe.

Phased closures are planned from Monday 21 August 2017 onwards, with estimated completion by 8 October 2017.

Highridge will be closed in sections, working southwards from Spring Lane to Naildown Road

**PHASE 1 – closure between Spring Lane and Woodlands Drive**  
Alternative route via Spring Lane and Woodlands Drive

**PHASE 2 – closure between Woodlands Drive and Quarry Walk**

**PHASE 3 – closure between Quarry Walk and Naildown Road**

Alternative route for phases 2 and 3 is via Spring Lane, Horn Street and Naildown Road

Access to the remainder of Highridge continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed at any time, but there will be no through access during the works.

Due to the nature of these works involving trenching, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

Access for residents affected by the closures will be maintained whenever it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.

The timing of the phases will depend on weather and ground conditions, and extents of closures will be notified to local residents and signposted on site.
