TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2) as amended by The Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

Kent County Council gives notice that Theatre Street, Hythe has been closed to through traffic, on 31st August 2017 for an estimated period of up to 13 days.

The road will be closed for the entire length.

There is no alternative route. Every effort will be made to maintain access for residents whenever it is safe to do so.

The closure is necessary to enable repairs to damaged sewers in the footway and carriageway to be carried out by Southern Water.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site, and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
