



KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
NORTH ROAD, HYTHE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new gas supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of North Road, Hythe.

A closure is planned from Monday 4 December 2017 for an estimated period of up to 3 days.

North Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 66, roughly mid-way along.

Access to the remainder of North Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed, but there will be no through access during these works.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via North Road, Station Road (Tanners Hill in opposite direction), East Street Roundabout, A259 Prospect Road, Rampart Road, Red Lion Square, Dymchurch Road, Scanlons Bridge, (Military Road in opposite direction), A261 London Road and Barrack Hill back to North Road.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
