**VARIOUS ROADS, SHEPWAY
– SURFACE TREATMENT**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

A261 HYTHE ROAD, PEDLINGE

To allow a programme of carriageway surface treatment works to be carried out, together with associated preparation and finishing, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on various roads throughout East Kent.

It will be necessary to close part of A261 Hythe Road, Pedlinge, near Hythe, to allow the reinstatement of centreline studs in the carriageway following earlier Surface Treatment works.

An overnight closure is planned for Wednesday 10 January 2018, from 20:00 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours.

A261 Hythe Road will be closed at various points between Newingreen and Hythe, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

~ There will be no direct access between Hythe and the A20 / Newingreen during these works ~

The alternative route is via A259 Military Road (Dymchurch Road in reverse), Rampart Road, Prospect Road, East Street, Seabrook Road, Sandgate Esplanade, Sandgate High Street, Sandgate Hill, Sandgate Road, Earls Avenue, Shorncliffe Road, Castle Hill Avenue, A2034 Cheriton Road, B2064 Cheriton High Street, Cheriton Interchange, A20 Ashford Road, Sandling Road, Stanford Intersection and Ashford Road, Newingreen.

Limited access to the remainder of the A261 continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed, but there will be no through access.
