



**KENT COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**HIGH STREET, HYTHE**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2018**

To allow works to be carried out to lay telecoms ducting in the carriageway, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of High Street, Hythe.

Overnight closures are planned from Tuesday 23 January 2018 for 2 nights, from 19:00 hours through until approximately 04:00 hours each night.

High Street will be closed in the general vicinity of the Post Office, with no through access between the junctions with Bank Street and Malthouse Hill

The alternative route for all through traffic is via East Street Roundabout, A259 Prospect Road, Rampart Road, Red Lion Square and High Street

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of High Street, Hythe will be suspended between the junctions with Bank Street and Malthouse Hill, to allow limited essential access / exit from either direction up to where the road is closed.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Bank Street, Hythe will be suspended between the junctions with Prospect Road / Chapel Street and High Street to allow access / exit.

This Order comes into force from 23 January 2018 and remains in force until the works have been completed, with a maximum duration of 6 months.
