PRINCES PARADE, SEABROOK

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow the safe use of a mobile crane to remove and then replace a telecoms mast, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Princes Parade, Seabrook, near Hythe.

Daytime closures are now planned for Monday 14 May 2018 and Wednesday 23 May 2018. If either date is unsuitable, works will be carried out the following day

Closures are between 08:00 hours and approximately 16:00 hours each day.

The use of a mobile crane is highly dependent on suitable weather, and if adverse weather prevents works going ahead on the dates advised above, new dates will be advised.

Princes Parade will be closed at its eastern end, just west of the junction with Court Road.

Access to the remainder of Princes Parade continues from a western (Hythe) direction up to where the road is actually closed, but there will be no through access during these works.

The alternative route for through traffic is via A259 Seabrook Road, Twiss Road (plus East Street in opposite direction) and Princes Parade.
