# **A259 EAST STREET ROUNDABOUT, HYTHE**

## **(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

### **TEMPORARY ORDER 2018**

To allow essential carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily restrict traffic in the vicinity of A259 East Street Roundabout, Hythe.

Overnight works are planned from Wednesday 6 June 2018 for up to 2 weekday nights, between 19:30 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

East Street Roundabout will be closed in two halves, with through traffic controlled by temporary traffic lights, and nearby roads closed as follows.

**STATION ROAD** – closed at the junction with East Street Roundabout.  
The alternative route is via A259 Prospect Road, Rampart Road, Red Lion Square, Dymchurch Road, (Military Road in opposite direction), Scanlons Bridge, A261 London Road, Barrack Hill, North Road, Hillcrest Road, Castle Road and Tanners Hill back to Station Road

**TWISS ROAD** – closed at the junction with East Street / Seabrook Road.  
The alternative route is via A259 Seabrook Road and Princes Parade (plus Court Road in opposite direction) back to Twiss Road

Whilst the northern side of the roundabout is closed, Bell Inn Road (Mill Lane) will be closed at the junction with the A259 and will become two-way so it can be reached via Mill Road

The One-way Traffic Orders will be suspended in respect of the following roads

- High Street, between the junctions with East Street Roundabout and Douglas Avenue
- Douglas Avenue, for its entire length
- Bell Inn Road, for its entire length
