A259 SEABROOK ROAD, HYTHE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow essential carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A259 Seabrook Road, Hythe.

Weekday overnight closures are planned from Tuesday 22 May 2018, with estimated completion by 6 June 2018.

Closures are Mondays to Fridays (except the Bank Holiday), from 19:30 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

A259 Seabrook Road will be closed between the junctions with Twiss Road and Cliff Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

~ There will be no direct access between Folkestone and Hythe using the A259 during these works ~

The alternative route for through traffic is via Twiss Road, Princes Parade (plus Court Road, eastbound only) back to A259 Seabrook Road, and vice versa.

Mill Road, Earlsfield Road, Elm Gardens and Cannongate Road will be closed at their junctions with Seabrook Road, with access to the remainder of each road continuing from their alternative junctions.

Operatives on site will allow managed access for any residents affected, including access to Saxon Close, Ferguson Close and Seabrook Grove, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons during active works.
