



KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
STATION ROAD, HYTHE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow essential carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Station Road, Hythe.

An overnight closure is planned for Tuesday 19 June 2018, from 19:30 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours.

Station Road will be closed between the junctions with A259 East Street Roundabout and North Road.

The alternative route is via A259 Prospect Road, Rampart Road, Red Lion Square, Dymchurch Road, Scanlons Bridge (Military Road in opposite direction), London Road, Barrack Hill, North Road, Hillcrest Road, Castle Road, Tanners Hill and North Road.

Mill Road will be closed at the junction with Station Road and can be accessed from its junction with A259 Seabrook Road.

Dental Street will be closed at the junction with Station Road and can be accessed from a western direction.

Tanners Hill can be accessed from Dental Street.

Access to High Street is unaffected.
