HORN STREET, CHERITON
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

To allow works to be carried out to upgrade the local sewer for new developments, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Horn Street, Cheriton, near Folkestone.

The closure is now planned from Monday 21 January 2019, with estimated completion by 29 April 2019.

Horn Street will be closed at its northern end, between St Martin's Primary School and the junction with Queen's Avenue.

Local access to the remainder of Horn Street continues from either direction up to where the road is closed, but there will be no through access during these works.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via Horn Street, A259 Seabrook Road, B2063 Hospital Hill, West Road, North Road, Military Road, Risborough lane and Church Road.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

Access for any residents affected will be maintained when it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.
