



KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
MILL ROAD, HYTHE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

To allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Mill Road, Hythe.

Closures are planned from Monday 4 March 2019 for up to 4 weeks.

Mill Road will be closed in 2 main phases, as indicated on site.
PHASE 1 – closure between the junctions with Bell Inn Road and Lower Blackhouse Hill
PHASE 2 – closure at the junction with A259 Seabrook Road

The alternative routes are
Eastbound via A259 Seabrook Road, East Street and Station Road
Westbound via Lower Blackhouse Hill and Station Road

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
