ALBERT LANE, HYTHE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

To allow excavations to be carried out to repair a sewer in the carriageway, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Albert Lane, Hythe.

A closure is planned from Monday 24 June 2019, with estimated completion by 5 July 2019.

Albert Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of Burton Hall, towards its eastern end.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Stade Street, Park Road and Albert Road.

Limited local access to the remainder of Albert Lane continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
