HIGH STREET, HYTHE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

For the safety of the public to help achieve social-distancing for economic recovery following the coronavirus pandemic, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of High Street, Hythe.

All vehicular traffic shall be prohibited on High Street between the junctions with Douglas Avenue and Bank Street.

The above restrictions apply from Monday to Saturday inclusive each week between 10:00 hours and 16:00 hours each day, thereby extending the current hours of pedestrianisation.

This Order comes into force from 20 June 2020 and remains in force for up to six months.

Whilst in force, this Order over-rides the existing Traffic Regulations that prohibit traffic on High Street, Hythe.

These restrictions have been requested by and in conjunction with Folkestone & Hythe District Council, and any enquires concerning this should be addressed directly to them.
