A261 HYTHE ROAD, PEDLINGE

TEMPORARY 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Kent County Council gives notice that for the safety of the public and workforce during roadworks, a temporary mandatory speed limit of 30 MPH will be imposed on a section of A261 Hythe Road, Pedlinge.

The 30 MPH restriction applies in both directions on A261 Hythe Road, Pedlinge between the junctions of A20 Stone Street and C564 from Lympe Town Boundary To A261 London Road, to the extent indicated by signage clearly displayed on site.

This takes effect on 10th August 2020 for up to 14 days. The restrictions will be lifted as soon as works are completed and it is safe to do so.

These works are in conjunction with Temporary Traffic Lights.

The restrictions have been introduced for the safety of the public and workforce whilst carriageway maintenance is to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
