LOWER WALL ROAD, WEST HYTHE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow culvert repair works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Lower Wall Road, West Hythe.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 9 November 2020, with estimated completion by 21 November 2020.

Lower Wall Road will be closed between the junctions with Tame Lane and Aldergate Lane.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Donkey Street, Thorndike Road, Church Road and Tame Lane back to Lower Wall Road.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [Kent County Council Permit GE40111404352-5], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
